The North Slope Borough School District has offered contracts to all three individuals as the Iñupiaq Language Teachers of the aboveforementioned sites/grade levels for the 2022 – 2023 school year. Prior Board approval is required by the Alaska Department of Education in addition to other specified requirements in order for teachers to be granted Type M certificates.
