**A RESOLUTION OF THE CLACKAMAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE, CLACKAMAS COUNTY,  
OREGON, AUTHORIZING THE COLLEGE TO NAME THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED  
NATURAL RESOURCES CENTER AFTER THE HOLDENS**

**WHEREAS**, Terry and Cheryl Holden have demonstrated longstanding generosity and commitment to Clackamas Community College, its students, and its career technical education programs through significant philanthropic support and advocacy; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2021, the Holdens made a historic \$5 million gift to Clackamas Community College Foundation and the College in support of career technical education, scholarships, veterans, and capital improvement initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, Terry and Cheryl Holden have now agreed to make an additional gift commitment in the total amount of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) to Clackamas Community College Foundation and Clackamas Community College pursuant to a gift and naming agreement with the Foundation; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of such gift, in the amount necessary to satisfy the College's naming threshold, will be applied to the College's 2024 Capital Bond Program for construction of the new Natural Resources Center, as approved by voters through the 2024 Clackamas Community College Capital Bond; and

**WHEREAS**, the pledged gift will result in a cumulative contribution of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) to the bond fund by December 31, 2030, thereby meeting the minimum naming rights requirement established by the CCC Foundation and in line with Board policy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education finds that acceptance of this gift and approval of the associated naming rights are in the best interests of Clackamas Community College and its students, and will significantly advance the College's mission by supporting development of the Natural Resources Center and related capital improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of this extraordinary philanthropic commitment, the Board of Education desires to approve naming the newly constructed Natural Resources Center after Terry and Cheryl Holden with the official name being determined in the future, subject to the terms and conditions of the agreement with the CCC Foundation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Education authorizes the College to name the soon to be newly constructed Natural Resources Center after Terry and Cheryl Holden with the official name being determined in the future.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Clackamas Community College Board of Education.
