

**RESOLUTION 10-28 - Approval for First Reading of Revised Board Policy
DDA – Local Service Plans**

This resolution is for first reading for revised Board Policy DDA – Local Service Plans.

Background: The Oregon Department of Education revised 541-0240-0285, which requires submission of the ESD adopted local service plan to ODE prior to June 30. It expands services designed to meet regional needs and allows for cooperation with other ESDs and school districts. It also allows for contracting with public and/or private entities for services as well as allowing the ESD to provide entrepreneurial services and facilities to non-component entities and other private or public entities. .

The Administrative Policy Review Team has reviewed the new laws and incorporated all required language into revised policy DDA – Local Service Plans.

The Superintendent recommends adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Administrative Policy Team has reviewed and incorporated all required language into revised Board Policy DDA – Local Service Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has reviewed revised Board Policy DDA – Local Service Plans..

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Board Policy DDA – Local Service Plans is approved for first reading as attached.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent is directed to bring Board Policy DDA – Local Service Plans back for second reading and adoption at the next regular meeting of the Board.

LOCAL SERVICE PLANS

~~The Board~~ MESD will ~~shall~~ provide ~~local~~ service ~~plans~~ to component districts **in accordance with the local service plan developed by MESD and component school districts. The plan must be adopted by the Board and developed to meet the following MESD service goals:**

1. **Assist component school districts in meeting the requirements of state and federal law;**
2. **Improve student learning;**
3. **Enhance the quality of instruction provided to students;**
4. **Provide professional development to component school district employees;**
5. **Enable component school districts and district students to have equitable access to resources; and**
6. **Maximize operational and fiscal efficiencies for component school districts.**

The local service plan will contain annual performance measures for MESD. The local service plan will also include services as required by state and federal law, and in the following areas:

1. **Special-Needs Students: The local service plan will include programs for children with special needs, including special education services, services for at-risk students and professional development for employees who provide those services.**
2. **Technology Support: The local service plan shall include technology support for component school districts and individual technology plans for each district. The ESD will provide technology infrastructure services, data services, instructional technology services, distance learning and professional development for employees who provide technology services.**
3. **School Improvement Services: The local service plan will include school improvement services for component school districts, including the following:**
 - a. **Services designed to support component school districts in meeting the requirements of state and federal law;**

- b. **Services designed to allow MESD to participate in and facilitate a review of the state and federal standards related to the provision of a quality education by component school districts;**
 - c. **Services designed to support and facilitate continuous school improvement planning;**
 - d. **Services designed to address school-wide behavior and climate issues;**
 - e. **Professional technical education; and**
 - f. **Professional development for employees who provide school improvement services.**
4. **Administrative and Support Services: The local service plan will include administrative and support services for component school districts, including services designed to consolidate component business functions, liaison services between the Department of Education and component school districts and registration of children being taught by private teachers, parents or legal guardians.**
 5. **Other services: Required under ORS 339.005 to 339.090 or services designed to meet regional needs.**
 6. **MESD may provide entrepreneurial services and facilities to non-component school district and other public and private entities pursuant to ORS 334.185.**

MESD may provide the services required by the local service plan in cooperation with another ESD, with a school district or contract with a private or public entity for services.

Following the adoption by the MESD Board, local service plan shall be approved on or before March 1 by resolution of at least two-thirds of the component school boards which have a majority of the students included in the ADM of MESD.

Prior to June 30 of each year MESD shall submit to the Department of Education the adopted local service plan.

~~“Local Service Plans” are facilities, programs and associated tasks that are provided by MESD for component districts. Such services shall be agreed to by component district Boards with the approval of MESD Board in accordance with ORS 334.175 (2) and applicable Oregon Administrative Rules. Local Service Plans may include, but not be limited to, central purchasing, library, curriculum material, special teachers, special programs and any other relevant service.~~

MESD’s decision-making process shall involve the participation of component districts in determining services. Local Service Plan needs may be identified and prioritized through MESD’s established planning process.

~~Local Service Plans shall be agreed upon on or before March 1 by resolution of two-thirds of the component Boards which have a majority of the students enrolled in the component districts of MESD.~~
