Suggested Plan for Browning Elementary School

We believe a combination of routine and periodic school visits combined with monthly planning and coaching sessions are the best methods to help the school progress in as rapid a fashion as possible. Our experience with rural schools indicates that a mix of in-person and web-based meetings can be just as effective and can be achieved at a lower cost.

We would recommend the following suggested schedule but would like to work with you to ensure this schedule is convenient:

- October (on-site): First two-day visit with leadership plus a three-day visit focusing on interventions. This two-day leadership visit focuses on beginning of the year literacy benchmark outcomes are analyzed (if available). The school is left with goals for the year and action steps to working toward these goals for the next visit. This three-day intervention visit focus would be to ensure the following:
 - Fidelity to the program
 - Appropriate placement of students
 - Implementation if Schools Cubed SIPPS progress monitoring system
 - Ensuring school wide master calendar provides adequate time for intervention
 - SIPPS Coaching
- November virtual coaching with leadership consultant and intervention consultant and a touch base to work through any possible implementation issues and problem solving.
- **December** virtual coaching with leadership consultant and intervention consultant and a touch base to work through any possible implementation issues and problem solving.
- **January:** virtual coaching with leadership consultant and intervention consultant and a touch base to work through any possible implementation issues and problem solving.
- **February:** virtual coaching with leadership consultant and intervention consultant and a touch base to work through any possible implementation issues and problem solving.
- **March:** virtual coaching with leadership consultant and intervention consultant and a touch base to work through any possible implementation issues and problem solving.
- **April:** virtual coaching with leadership consultant and intervention consultant and a touch base to work through any possible implementation issues and problem solving.
- May/June (on-site): Option for 2 day in-person visit. The last visit of the school year is based on the
 literacy outcomes of the school, as measured by the benchmark assessment. This visit measures
 growth by both students and teachers. Through the use of a Schools Cubed protocol, the
 effectiveness of grade-level instruction will be analyzed and next steps for the following school year



will be addressed. During this last onsite, we will analyze end-of-year data, schedule interventions for the following year.
