TASB Policy Update 123 with Revisions to CDC(LOCAL)

PURPOSE OF REPORT

TASB Policy Update 123 encompasses changes in law from the 88th Regular and Special Legislative Sessions that have an immediate effect on the governance and management of the district. Changes to local policies offered for consideration address the following topics: Board member training, ethics, safety programs & risk management, technology resources, employment practices, complaints and grievances, and instructional arrangements and resources. Update 123 includes the changes to the following local policies:

- CKE(LOCAL): SAFETY PROGRAMS/RISK MANAGEMENT SECURITY PERSONNEL
- CQC(LOCAL): TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES EQUIPMENT
- DCE(LOCAL): EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES OTHER TYPES OF CONTRACTS
- DGBA(LOCAL): PERSONNEL-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS EMPLOYEE COMPLAINTS/GRIEVANCES
- EEH(LOCAL): INSTRUCTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION
- EFA(LOCAL): INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS
- EFB(LOCAL): INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES LIBRARY MATERIALS
- FNG(LOCAL): STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES STUDENT AND PARENT COMPLAINTS/GRIEVANCES
