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#### TASB Policy Update 123 with Revisions to CDC(LOCAL)

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##### **PURPOSE OF REPORT**

TASB Policy Update 123 encompasses changes in law from the 88<sup>th</sup> Regular and Special Legislative Sessions that have an immediate effect on the governance and management of the district. Changes to local policies offered for consideration address the following topics: Board member training, ethics, safety programs & risk management, technology resources, employment practices, complaints and grievances, and instructional arrangements and resources. Update 123 includes the changes to the following local policies:

- BBD(LOCAL): BOARD MEMBERS – TRAINING AND ORIENTATION
- BBFA(LOCAL): ETHICS – CONFLICT OF INTEREST DISCLOSURES
- CKC(LOCAL): SAFETY PROGRAMS/RISK MANAGEMENT – EMERGENCY PLANS
- CKE(LOCAL): SAFETY PROGRAMS/RISK MANAGEMENT – SECURITY PERSONNEL
- CQC(LOCAL): TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES - EQUIPMENT
- DCE(LOCAL): EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES – OTHER TYPES OF CONTRACTS
- DGBA(LOCAL): PERSONNEL-MANAGEMENT RELATIONS – EMPLOYEE COMPLAINTS/GRIEVANCES
- EEH(LOCAL): INSTRUCTIONAL ARRANGEMENTS – HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION
- EFA(LOCAL): INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES – INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS
- EFB(LOCAL): INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES – LIBRARY MATERIALS
- FNG(LOCAL): STUDENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES – STUDENT AND PARENT COMPLAINTS/GRIEVANCES
- GF(LOCAL): PUBLIC COMPLAINTS

It is further recommended that additional changes be made to the following local policies:

- CDC(LOCAL): OTHER REVENUES – GIFTS AND SOLICITATIONS
