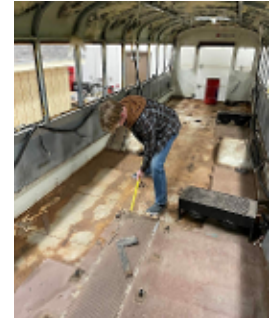

MIDDLE SCHOOL CHARACTER CHALLENGE:

For the month of April, staff have been on the hunt for demonstrations of positive character. "Marks" identifying poor character are being documented daily in an effort to celebrate students consistently supporting a positive school climate.

- ▶ Weekly lunch hour prizes for students with no marks!
- ▶ Movie & popcorn party with grand prize drawings for any students with no marks for the entire month of April!
- ▶ Grade level competition for the class most consistently demonstrating positive character throughout the month!
- ▶ End of the year field trip for students demonstrating positive character at least 80% of the time!

The number of "marks" recorded by staff reduced from 34% to 21% in the second week of the challenge!
