### PROGRAM SALES UPDATE -

December was a tough month due to inclement weather. With the loss of 2 full school days, one additional day out in the Illinois Valley and late start on 3 days for the entire District, this took its toll on participation. Lunches were (6624) under budget while breakfasts sales were (5365) under budget. Catering was lost due to cancellations of meals while both snack and supper meal counts were low as programs were shut down with no meals served. We hope to make up the counts with continuous focus on driving participation at every site.

#### SAFETY UPDATE -

As a continued focus on Safety, Food Service Staff reviews 5 minutes safety topics each month. Below are our topics for February:

This month, as part of the monthly Kitchen Manager Meetings our training agenda is:

- Chemical Hazard Communication Information about proper use, storage and handling of chemicals in the kitchen.
- Receiving and Storing Guidelines for ensuring food safety for all products delivered to the kitchens.
- Preventing Burns Easy Do's and Don'ts to prevent burns.
- Sanitizing Food Contact Surfaces Proper methods for cleaning and sanitizing food contact surfaces in the kitchen to ensure a clean, healthy environment.



We will continue this school year with staff awareness, increased focus and informative training throughout the school year. Food and Nutrition Services continues to provide a safe working environment in all our schools as well as incorporating safe work place practices district wide by keeping SAFETY top of mind!
