Consider Approval of Renewal of Contract 2024.515 Online Math Curriculum for Secondary

Background:

In June 2024, the Board approved the award of Contract 2024.515 Online Math Curriculum for Secondary, in the amount of \$130,000 for a two-year term through July 2026, with one additional one-year renewal option. To date, \$57,895 of the approved amount has been encumbered. This contract provides online math curriculum resources for grades 6-12, supporting student engagement, retention, and teacher instruction. With the implementation of the Bluebonnet math adoption beginning in the 2026–2027 school year, additional digital resources and professional learning will be required. To support this transition, it is recommended that the contract be renewed early and additional funding be allocated to include these resources and training. The cost for the Bluebonnet digital math resources is estimated to be approximately \$800,000 for three years and will be funded through IMTA funds. It is the recommendation of the Director of Purchasing to renew Contract 2024.515 Online Math Curriculum for Secondary, for an estimated annual contract value of \$900,000. This is the final renewal option available for this contract.
