



Reasons for Leaving:

- 8 relocated outside of Illinois
- 7 retired
- 7 resigned to avoid non-renewal
- 5 took teaching jobs closer to home
- 4 cited family reasons
- 3 took another teaching job
- 3 accepted administrator jobs
- 3 resigned mid-year in 2017-2018
- 3 on year-long leave of absence
- 3 had contracts that were not renewed
- 2 accepted a job as instructional leader
