Manzanita is a great place to learn and grow. The following are some highlights and updates on happenings at Manzanita thus far this year.

**Student Announcers:** Each day Manzanita begins our day in the gym. This allows for general morning announcements, school-wide flag salute and it fosters a sense of community. With the assistance of Mrs. Hults, Announcements are led by our 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students. Individual classrooms present each month; September-Mr. Granger's class, October, Mrs. Chamberlain's class and November Mr. Davidson's class. This gives our students the opportunity to speak in front of their peers. We are adding in classical music appreciation by Mrs. Northcross and student book talks.
