Bus Schedules Revised
All Three Rivers School District Middle and High Schools
Effective Tuesday, March 8, 2011

As part of the Three Rivers School District's efforts to cut costs, it has been decided to cut 5 bus routes throughout the county to save approximately \$85,000 beginning on March 8 (the start of the third trimester) until the end of the current school year. This action will result in several routes being consolidated. It also requires the district to increase by ten minutes the difference between the start of the elementary school day and the middle and high school day. As a result all the secondary school schedules will be 10 minutes later than before. The schools affected are listed below with the new start and end times.

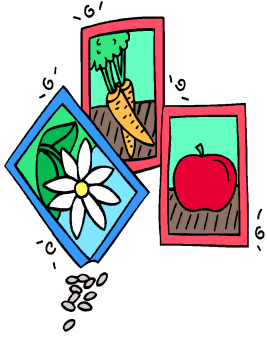
FAMILY ADVOCATE CORNER

If you know a little boy or girl that would love a Colts comforter set, I have one! It will fit a twin bed and is excellent condition.



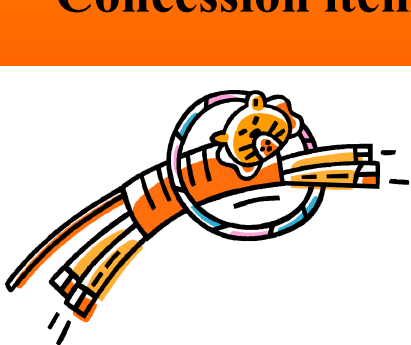
