Proposal for Public Address System Upgrades at Monroe Center and Highland

Date: January 3, 2025

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Background

In 2023, Meridian CUSD #223, leveraged a COPS Grant to enhance office entrances, including secure vestibules. In 2024, we again leveraged a COPS Grant to improve security across the district, including installing security cameras in all four buildings and a new PA system at Meridian Junior High School (MJHS). With this grant, we pre-wired MCES and HES for PA systems. However, we did not have enough grant funds to cover the costs of PA systems in all four buildings. In a third attempt at a COPS Grant to provide new PA systems at HES, MCES, and SVHS, we were denied the grant for a third year.

Rationale for Additional Upgrades

Critical Deficiencies at MCES and HES

- Outdated systems malfunction regularly, require frequent reprogramming, and lack reliable vendor support.
- Poor sound quality and insufficient coverage, with no speakers in hallways, gymnasiums, or multipurpose areas.
- Modern technology will include visual notification, zoned paging, and digital hallway clocks.

What if we build new?

All equipment (camera and PA equipment) can be moved to a different location.
The only piece of equipment that would not move is cabling. The cost of cabling is minimal in comparison to the equipment itself.

What remaining work needs to be done?

- SVHS is also in need of an updated PA system; however, it is not in as dire need as the other three buildings
- The cost of SVHS would be about \$200,000 due to the coverage and equipment needed.

Proposed Upgrades

1. Monroe Center Elementary School (\$89,000)

- o Installation of a new intercom, clock, and paging system.
- Addition of 29 classroom clocks/speakers, 53 in-ceiling speakers, and 8 wall-mounted paging horns.
- Upgrade to Algo 8420 display speakers for visual alerts.

2. Highland Elementary School (\$76,500)

- o Installation of a new intercom, clock, and paging system.
- Addition of 24 classroom clock/speakers, 43 in-ceiling speakers, and 3 wall-mounted paging horns.
- Upgrade to Algo 8420 display speakers for improved communication.
