**SUBJECT:** Revised Policy 8320 Weber School District Student Appropriate Use Policy

on a second read

Policy 8320 Weber School District Student Appropriate Use Policy has been updated to ensure that technology resources are used responsibly to enhance student learning while maintaining a safe and secure digital environment. Key points in this policy include:

- <u>Expectations</u>: Students must act in a safe, respectful, and lawful manner when using district-owned or personal devices on school networks.
- Monitoring: Use of district technology is a privilege and subject to monitoring; no expectation of privacy exists.
- <u>Internet Safety:</u> Filtering and monitoring systems are in place to comply with federal law (CIPA) and protect students from harmful content.
- Acceptable Use: Students may only use technology with teacher direction for legitimate educational purposes.
- <u>Prohibited Conduct:</u> Accessing inappropriate materials, cyberbullying, hacking, unauthorized access, or sharing personal information is strictly prohibited.
- <u>Discipline</u>: Violations may result in suspension of access, disciplinary action (up to expulsion), financial liability, or legal consequences.
- <u>Parent/Student Agreement</u>: Annual acknowledgment of the policy is required by both students and parents.
