Background Information:

- In accordance with TEC 31.04, school districts are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the commissioner, that, for each subject in the required curriculum other than physical education, students have access to instructional materials that cover all the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS).
- The certification must be ratified by the District's board of trustees or governing body in an open, public-noticed meeting.

Administrative Considerations:

- Instructional materials for the upcoming school year will not change from previous school years. The resources still in use need to be certified, and the certification submitted to the Texas Education Agency.
- The administration recommends that the Board of Trustees ratify that each subject in the required curriculum meets the certification requirements and students have access to instructional materials that cover all of the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills.
