

Seventy one MEF grants totaling over \$185,000 were awarded to 80 teachers to enhance classroom

over \$185,000 were awarded to 80 teachers to enhance classroom learning in the 2024-2025 school year. The foundation has funded almost \$3 million in grants since 2001.

JEANIE HOLDBROOK MOSS SCHOLARSHIPS

Established by an endowment from the Moss family in 2001, this scholarship was established to assist Midway ISD staff members in pursuit of a bachelors, masters, or doctoral degree to be used in teaching MISD students. 32 scholarships have been awarded,

222 GROW YOUR OWN SCHOLARS

The GROW YOUR OWN full or partial scholarship pays for the MCC alternative certification program including coursework and internship. This year we were able to award 4 scholars alongside Midway ISD's HR Department. 22 scholars have been awarded since 2019!



The Ed Foundation helped provide 9 Special Olympic Letter Jackets and 36 Academic Letter Jackets, with over 150 students qualifying by earning a GPA of 97 for 6 semesters.
