In addition, Policy Service's recent migration to Word 2013 causes some margin notes to appear as a tracked change where no change has taken place.

II expires in 2004. Subsequent elections shall take place in 2007 and 2010, and at three-year intervals thereafter in a like manner.

Position 3 The current term of position 3 in both Sub-District I and Sub-District

> II expires in 2002. Subsequent elections shall take place in 2005 and 2008, and at three-year intervals thereafter in a like manner.

At Large One Boardof the District's Trustees shall be elected at-large in

> 2002 to serve a three-year term expiring in 2005. In the same manner, one member shall be elected at large forin 2005 to a three-year term-expiring in 2008, with elections held in 2020, 2023,

2026, and inconducted at three-year intervals thereafter.

held in 2019, 2022, 2025, and in three-year intervals thereafter.

Districts 4 and 6 The election for single-member district numbers 4 and 6 shall be

held in 2020, 2023, 2026, and in three-year intervals thereafter.
