

### **ADD POLICY**

#### **Electioneering**

When the District is used as an official polling place, political advertising, campaign communications and electioneering, as those terms are used in state law, shall be permitted in accordance with the following:

- Signs no larger than 24 inches by 24 inches (four square feet) may be placed or posted on District property;
- Each candidate, political party, or committee supporting or opposing a measure or candidate on the ballot shall be limited to placing or posting a maximum of five signs at each designated District polling site;
- Placement or posting of signs shall be restricted to the primary entrances of the property and areas where voters will be entering the District facility or other such location, as determined by the District. The placement of signs shall not make arrival or dismissal of student unsafe nor obstruct ingress or egress of the District site;
- Signs must be staked in the ground;
- Signs shall not be placed or posted in shrubs or flowerbeds; and
- Signs shall not be attached or affixed to existing poles, posts, other signs, or District buildings.

Damage to District property shall be prohibited.

The placement or posting of signs at active polling places in the District shall be permitted after 8:00 p.m. on Mondays through Fridays or any time on Saturdays and Sundays and no earlier than one day prior to the first day of voting at each polling place. All signs must be removed within one day following the last day of voting at each polling place. If signs are not picked up or removed, the District shall dispose of the signs.

Equipment such as a tent, awning, or shelter shall not be permitted on District property. In addition, equipment such as a megaphone or microphone that amplifies sound shall not be permitted on District property within 1000 feet of the polling location.

District staff shall be authorized to remove and dispose of any sign placed or posted on District property that does not comply with the provisions of this policy. For purposes of this policy, sign shall mean any political advertisement or political campaign sign, card, or poster.
