Swiss Behavior Triangle for February –

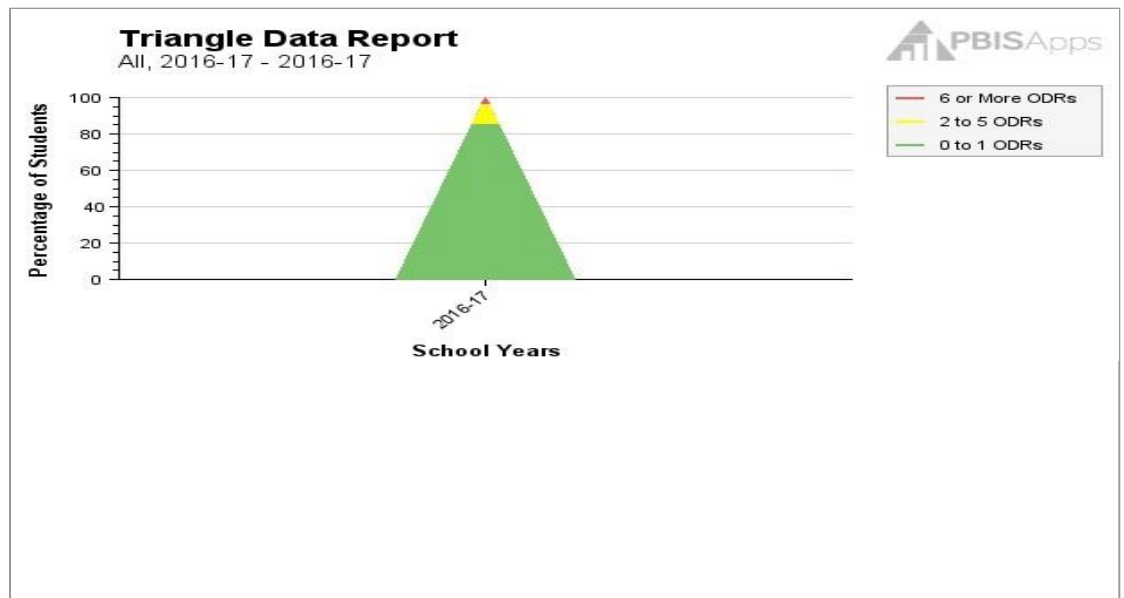
