Background Information

The purpose of these showcases is to celebrate and highlight the happenings in our schools and district. Each week a member of the Leadership Team will highlight an activity, group or individual from our district.

The showcase for tonight's meeting is Hannah Coyle, Board Chair and the **Red Wing Royal Ambassador Organization**

This year, RWPS 2024 graduate Kendra Carlisle, and class of 2025 seniors Bryn Guse and Cadence Moffet are representing Red Wing.

The Red Wing Royal Ambassador Organization is a volunteer-run nonprofit, scholarship organization dedicated to cultivating community, professionalism, and volunteerism among young women in Red Wing through its flagship candidate and ambassador programs. Through engaging events, it fosters confidence and independence, showcasing how young women can become active contributors to their community, while growing their professional skills.

The primary role of a Red Wing Royal Ambassador is to serve and represent "Pretty Little Red Wing" at communities across the state; promote and participate in the annual River City Days festival and the Red Wing Holiday Stroll; and volunteer and promote local events, businesses, and encourage tourism to the community.

The 2024 Red Wing Royal Ambassadors, Cadence Moffett, Kendra Carlisle, and Bryn Guse, volunteer their time to local elementary schools; participate in events for other local non-profit organizations and businesses; and visit several assisted living facilities.

Each Ambassador, all of equal standing, is required to volunteer for a non-profit organization of her choice, in addition to ambassador events. As part of candidacy, each participant researches and speaks publicly about the organization she would like to support if chosen as an Ambassador.

At the end of their year of service, each ambassador receives a scholarship up to \$2,000 to help fund her education.
