



**BOARD OF TRUSTEES
RESOLUTION DECLINING TO ADOPT POLICY RELATING TO A PERIOD OF
PRAYER AND READING OF THE BIBLE OR OTHER RELIGIOUS TEXT**

WHEREAS, the 89th Legislature passed Senate Bill No. 11 (“the Bill”) relating to a period of prayer and reading of the Bible or other religious text in public schools; and

WHEREAS, the Bill requires the Board of Trustees to take a record vote on whether to adopt a policy requiring every campus of Millsap ISD to provide a period of prayer and reading of the Bible or other religious text as provided by Section 25.0823, Education Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees carefully considered the policy in conjunction with (1) the education interests of students and (2) the time necessary for educators to prepare for, and instruct students in, curriculum courses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that adopting the policy set forth in Section 25.0823, Education Code, is not in the best interest of Millsap ISD.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Millsap Independent School District as follows:

1. The Board of Trustees adopts the foregoing recitals as findings of fact.
2. The Board of Trustees declines to adopt the policy set forth in Section 25.0823, Education Code, relating to a period of prayer and reading of the Bible or other religious text.
