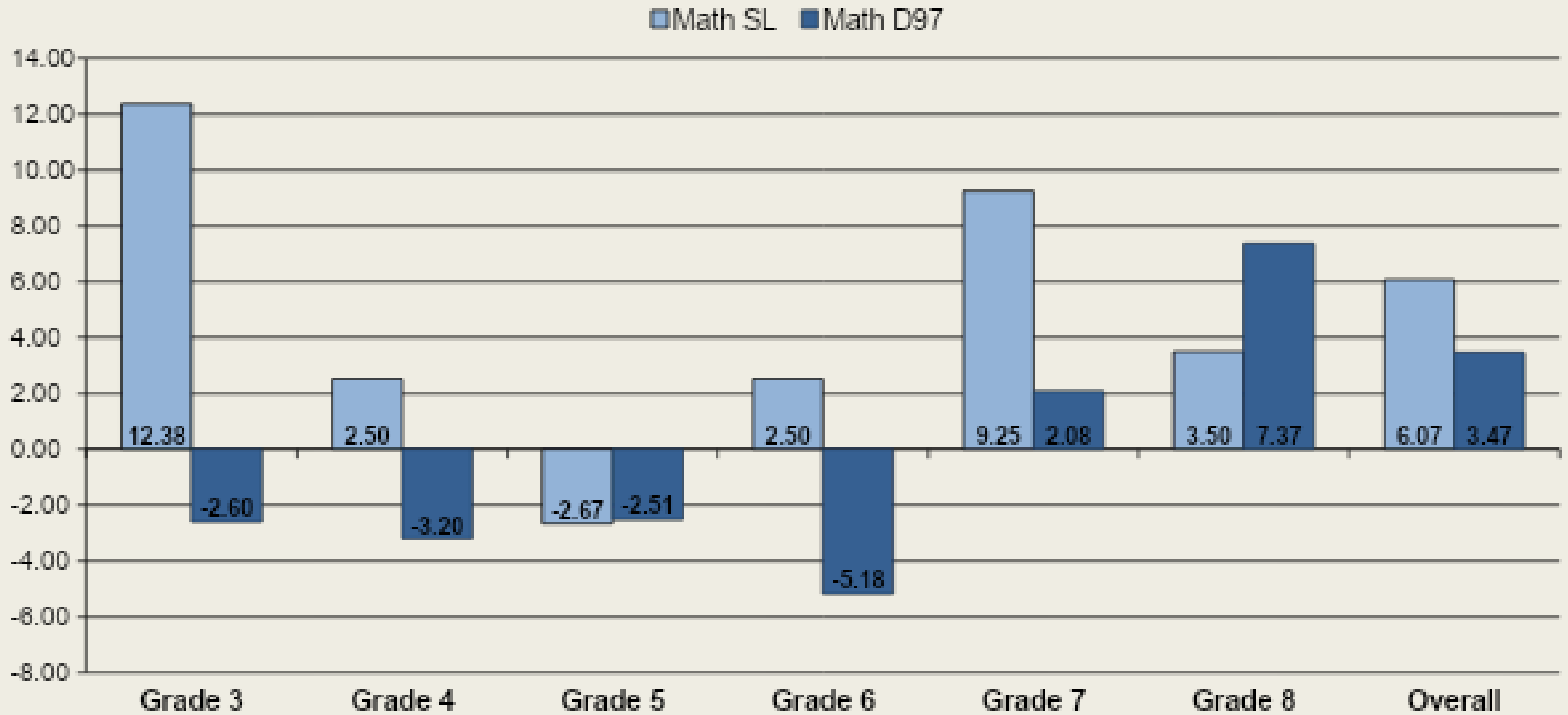

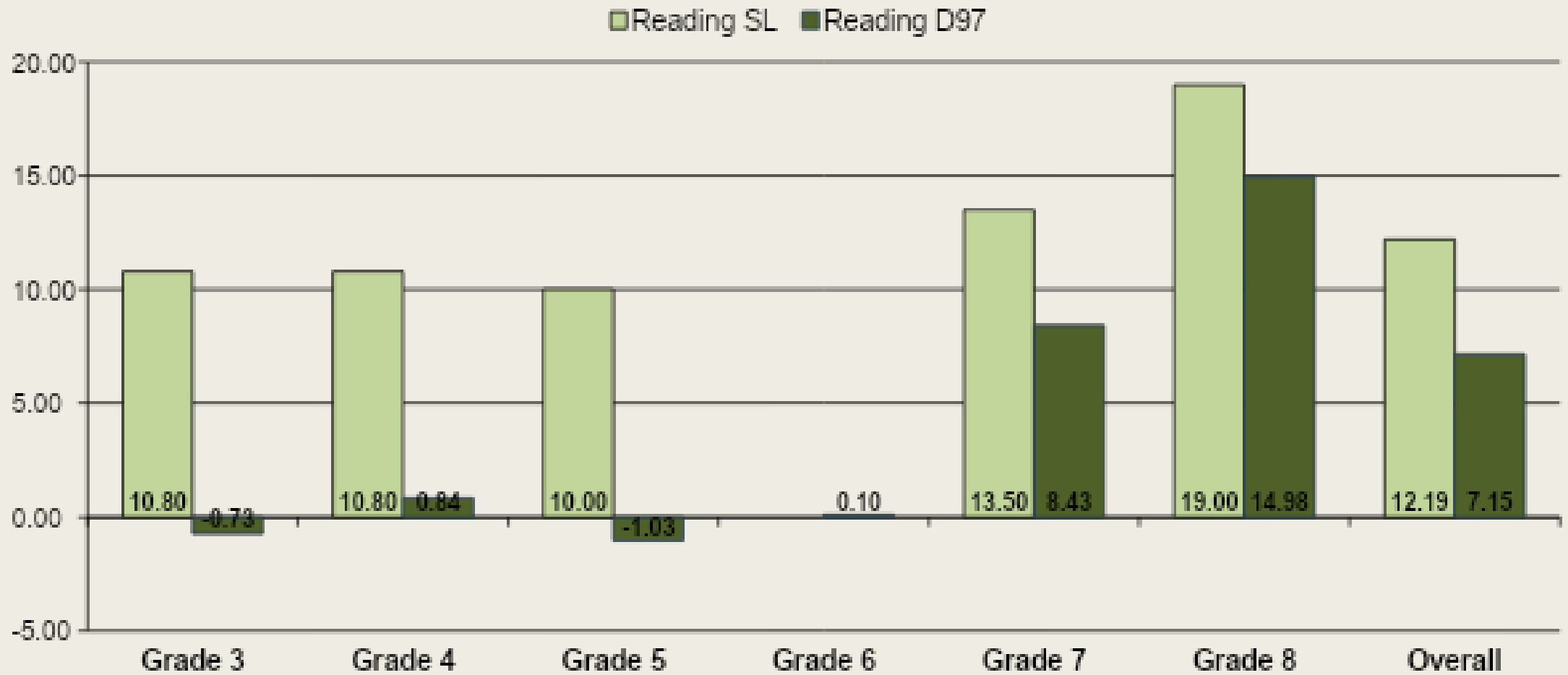

K-4 Summer Launch Program

2019 Successes

- Increased Summer Launch enrollment in grades K-4
- Strengthened K-4 curriculum and collected a variety of data throughout the program
- Summer Launch attendees outperformed District 97 Tier 3 students who did not attend Summer Launch in reading & mathematics

2020 Areas of Opportunity

- Continue to develop mathematics curriculum to ensure it meets the needs of all students
- Communicate Summer Launch information with parents earlier in January 2020

5-8 Summer Launch Program

2019 Successes

- Increased Summer Launch enrollment in grades 5-8
- Revamped Summer Launch curriculum for students
- Summer Launch attendees outperformed District 97 Tier 3 students who did not attend Summer Launch in reading & mathematics

2020 Areas of Opportunity

- Continue to develop the curriculum to include projects that are relatable to all students
- Build upon the reading component of the program to meet the needs of all students
- Revise the 8th grade STEAM project to ensure high levels of engagement for our students

K-8 Summer Launch Program Changes

2020 Program Recommendations

- Send applications to D97 staff in January and secure positions by the end of February
- Send invitation letters to families in January
- Continue Reading/Writing Workshop model for grades K-4
- Continue to embed Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) into our balanced literacy framework for grades K-4
- Continue to partner with HEPH ED Steam to develop curriculum and assessments for grades 5-8

Student Selection Criteria

SUMMER LAUNCH

Non-negotiable : Students invited to Summer Launch must be identified as Tier 3 during the school year.

- Must be Tier 3 based on at least one benchmark assessment: MAP, aimswebPLUS, OR BAS at or below the 10th percentile
- Based on the assessments at least 2 data points will be used for identification

Note: EL students will be included. Students with IEPs should be included, if they are not invited to ESY (per their IEP).

NEWCOMER ENGLISH LEARNER SUMMER PROGRAM

- A program designed to support English Learner students in grades 1-8
- Students who are new to the United States and acquiring the English language
