Recall - Proclamation 2017

- CTE Materials that were adopted as a part of the 2017 Proclamation were purchased on a 7-year contract with IMTA funding.
- Quotes for all 2017 renewals were unsustainable without the use of IMTA funding.
- The CTE team is re-evaluating the remaining CTE resources outside of the Proclamation 2024 adoption due to expiring contracts, the addition of new CTE courses since 2017, as well as updated resources to align with industry standards and Industry-Based Certifications.
 - IBC implementation came into effect after Proc 2017



Student View of eDynamic Learning Platform








Student View of iCEV Platform


- Platform currently used within LISD
