Student & Parent Handbook Changes 2024 - 2025

Grading Policy:

Elementary Campuses - Grade Levels: 1st - 5th Grades

Grading Expectations:

- Single grading category (all grades per subject carry equal weight in determining a student's report card average in a subject area in grades 1st - 2nd.)
- Weighted Grading Categories (3rd, 4th & 5th) Daily Work = 75%, Quizzes/Tests = 25%
- * Weighted grading categories will now include 3rd grade.

Other Changes:

- Mastery of Work Students will be given one week from the time the grade is posted to redo any failing assignment as long as they originally attempted the assignment for a maximum grade of 70 (documented in Skyward notes.)
- Late work will be accepted up to 5 days late with a penalty of 5 points for each day late.
 Student refusal to complete work will be documented with parent contact/notification.
 Late work grades will be documented in Skyward.

* The maximum grade a student can receive if they redo an assignment, or after 5 days an assignment is late.

Promotion and Retention Policy:

In grades 1st – 8th, promotion is based on a student receiving a grade of at least 70 based on course-level standards for all subject areas and a grade of 70 or above in the following areas: language arts, mathematics, science and social studies.
