Re: Security Camera Storage Proposal

Coppell ISD needs to increase security camera storage capacity:

- For additional security cameras for all campuses
- For requirements of new higher resolution cameras
- For retention standard of 14 days
- To set up a scalable solution for future expansion and addition of new schools
- To meet the storage needs requirements of SB507 for SpEd classrooms

SB507 requires that districts provide video capture equipment for SpEd classrooms that have the capacity for 6 months of video retention.

The *Isilon* storage solution provides 416TB aggregate pool capacity to handle projected future camera replacements and growth. This solution will provide centralized storage for our security camera servers which will be virtualized to allow easy expansion and provide failover in the event a camera server needs to be restarted. The pricing includes installation and 5 years of hardware and software support. There is one component software license that only includes a maximum of 3 years of support. The additional annual cost is approximately \$1000/year.

The Technology Department has reviewed bids in collaboration with the Purchasing Department and recommends *Technologent* for system setup and implementation.
