

Community College Transfer Pathway

Major → Oregon Transfer Model (1-2yrs.) to continue at a university

Scholarship → General school foundation scholarships

Paid district summer internship → Pays up to \$3,000/per summer/student

Traditional University Pathway (ex: Pacific, PSU, George Fox)

Major → Elementary, middle, & high school licensure tracks

Graduate Studies → Master's degree earns your teaching license

Scholarship → Oregon Teachers Scholars Program

Paid district summer internship → Pays up to \$3,000/per summer/student

Western Oregon University Pathway

Major → Elementary, middle, & high school licensure tracks (no Master's degree required)

Scholarship → WOU Bilingual Teachers Scholars Program

Paid district summer internship → Pays up to \$3,000/per summer/student

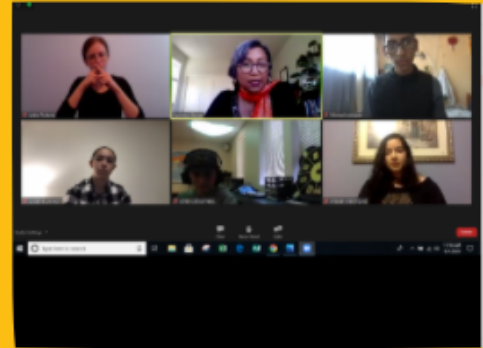

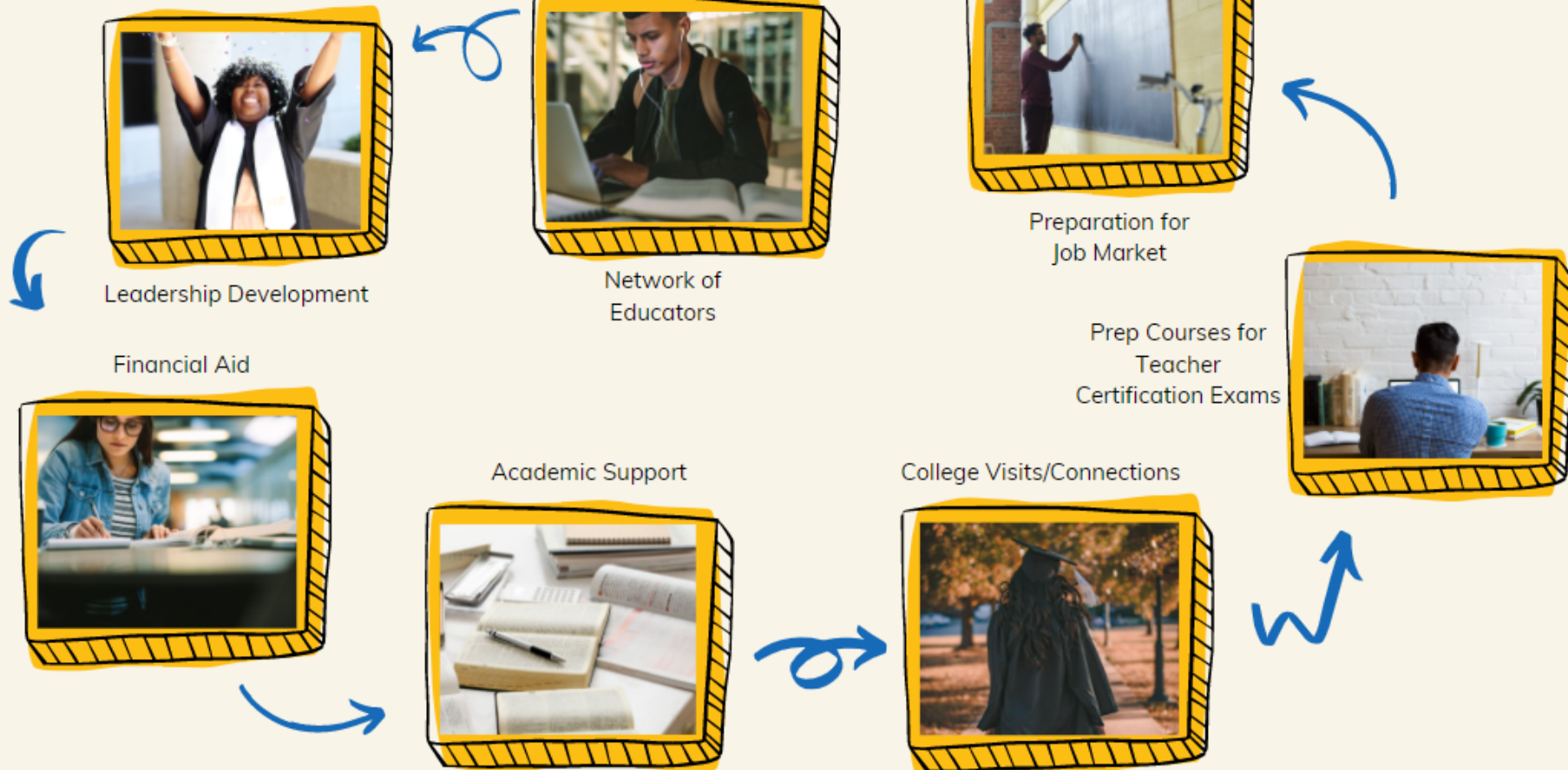
