- 7:00am Load bus For Diamond Head State Park Hawaii's most recognized landmark is known for its historic hiking trail, stunning coastal views, and military history. This broad, saucer-shaped crater was formed about 300,000 years ago during a single, explosive eruption that sent ash and fine particles in the air.
HIKING THE TRAIL: From the trailhead to the summit of Diamond Head Crater, you will hike 0.8 mile (1.3 km) one way and climb 560 feet (171 m) from the crater floor. The trail follows an uneven and steep terrain requiring caution and appropriate footwear. Portions of the trail involve steep stairways - take your time. Other portions of the trail go through a long tunnel which is lighted. Allow 1.5 to 2 hours for a safe and leisurely round-trip hike.

- 11:30am Load bus and drop off at Ala Moana Mall to enjoy shopping and spend time on the beach.
