Baseball-

Varsity baseball finished their district tournament as the number three seed. They also finished the regular season as the number three ranked team in the state, which qualifies them for the state tournament. Baseball's state tournament is a little different this year. Eight teams qualify for the state tournament play in games. There will be four play in series. Those series will be the best two out of three. Winners of those four play in series will earn a spot in the state championships the following weekend in a true double elimination state four team tournament.
