# COMPUTER LEASE PROGRAM Background

- United ISD's last computer lease commenced Summer 2010
  - Over 3,500 desktops (HP 8000 Elite) were placed throughout the district
  - Units were disseminated to comply with the District Technology plan's student to computer ratios
    - Elementary 4:1
    - Secondary 3:1
  - Lease was only for STUDENT computers (not teachers or administrators)
  - In 2010, UISD was receiving \$1.1 Million (about \$30 per student) for technology needs through the Technology Allotment; these funds now come through the Instructional Materials Allotment (IMA)

## NEW COMPUTER LEASE PROGRAM Timeline

- September 2013: United ISD's Technology Department produced a computer inventory listing per campus including model and age of equipment:
  - A. Identified about 4,800 units over 5 years old which will be replaced with the new computer lease
  - B. An additional 1,750 units (1/2) from the last (2010) lease will be replaced while the remaining units will be used in the lower grades for 2 more years as we roll out the Mobile Learning Devise (MLD) plan

# NEW COMPUTER LEASE PROGRAM Timeline (Cont'd)

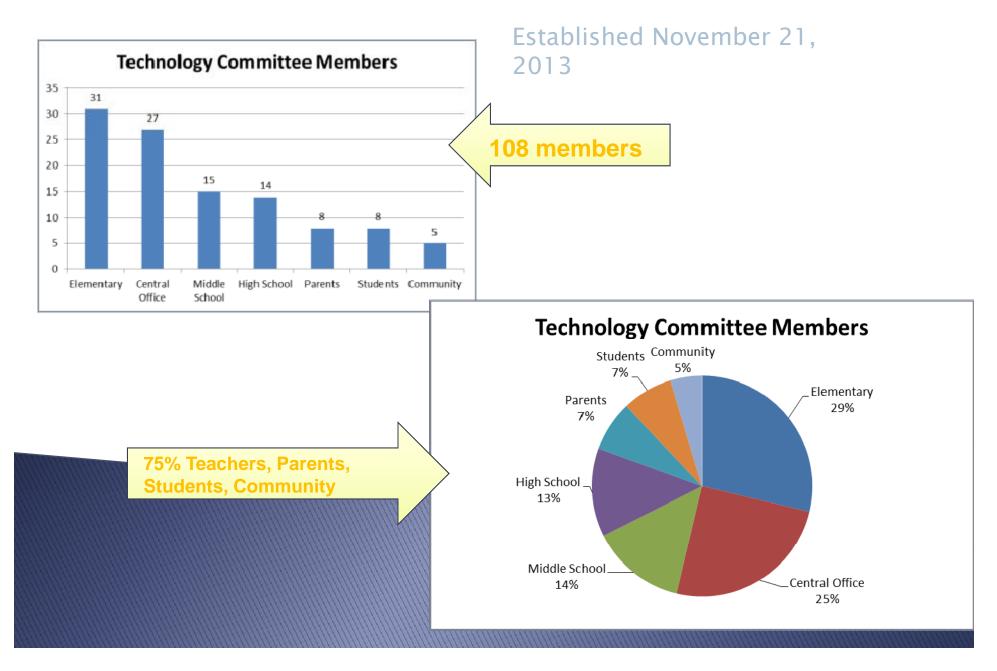

## Financing Options Recommended:

- Total new lease amount for 7,486 student units & 657 teachers units along with accessories, carts and related technology equipment is \$5.8 M
- Annual lease payment over (4) years is estimated to be \$ 1.55 M per year based on a 2.63% lease rate factor
  - The current (2010) lease annual payment was \$1.23M
- To facilitate the MLD rollout, the District will purchase \$1 M for Airwatch and iPad Apps, and also update Microsoft office to 2010 version.
