Goal

Generate revenue in State appropriations, tuition, and fees to equal instructional expenses to ensure the financial stability of Collin College into the future



Instructional Costs

- Faculty Salaries
- Benefits
- Contractual Expenses
- Faculty Development
- Non-Capital Equipment and Furniture
- Operating Expenses
- Supplies



Tuition Philosophy

- Minimal tuition for property tax payers
- Affordable tuition for students
- ▶ Tuition lower than regional community colleges
- Tuition below the state average
