**The Keller Independent School District will develop and promote positive community relations through effective communication, the involvement of stakeholders, and the establishment of business and community partnerships.**

**FISCAL NOTE: None**

**Background Information:**

- The High School Boundary Adjustment Review Committee (BARC) was formed in July 2006.
- The forty-four members consist of parents of children grades K-8 from all three of the current high school feeder patterns.
- The committee held its first meeting on August 31, 2006 and has met eight times to date, most recently on June 7.
- Committee meetings have focused on criteria development, demographic updates including impact of multi-family developments, building capacity studies, the scenario development process, and proposed scenario refinements.

**Administrative Considerations:**

- The administration will share work to date on potential boundaries and considerations with no recommendation or action planned until Fall 2007.
