Update: In Person Learning and Remote Learning



School year 2021-2022 will continue with In Person Learning

BPS will continue with full time in person, on campus learning for the 2021-2022 school year. This in person learning will be supported by a remote learning option that will be available to all students beginning the 3rd quarter which starts on January 18, 2022. Per the BPS Covid plan a transition to Blended Learning will occur when approved by the BPS Board of Trustees. Blended Learning is a combination of in person learning and remote learning where the students attend on a set schedule.

In order to support our students and families immediately BPS will be offering optional remote learning by request to all students of BPS. Students and families will begin this request

process by contacting their student's building principal or assistant principal.

BPS understands the stress and strain caused by Covid, yet we also want to keep in mind the learning loss of students resulting from not being in person and on campus.
