Discussion of Attendance Boundary Modifications

Board Goals:

Parent and Community Involvement – Foster a positive and welcoming environment that encourages parent and community partnerships to achieve success for all our students; work continuously with the community in planning and facility development;

Growth, Change & Fiscal Responsibility – Review and adjust policies and procedures as appropriate to address the challenges of rapid growth and changing demographic characteristics while maintaining and enhancing our strong sense of community; and, create and continuously modify strategies to mitigate increasing stresses on our children, our schools and our community

Purpose of Report:

To provide the Board of Trustees an overview of proposed attendance boundary modifications to Cross Oaks Elementary School and Providence Elementary School.

Objectives:

During recent attendance boundary discussions, the District explored the impact of future developments on the enrollment at Cross Oaks Elementary. With current attendance boundaries, these future developments would have significant impact to enrollment capacity at Cross Oaks Elementary. After review of demographic impact research provided by Templeton Demographics, we propose adjusting the attendance boundaries of Cross Oaks and Providence Elementary Schools to allow this future development to be included in the Providence Elementary School boundary.

Operational Impact:

Operational impact is minimal. At the time of these discussions these developments have yet to begin construction.

Results:

Advantages:

Modifications to the Cross Oaks Elementary School attendance boundary would address the significant impact to enrollment capacity anticipated if the future development remains within the current attendance boundary of Cross Oaks Elementary. Adjustments while no homes are

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completed, would allow the District to avoid rezoning attendance boundaries after students in this development begin attending our schools.

Disadvantages:

Modifications to the attendance boundaries of Cross Oaks Elementary School and Providence Elementary require continued monitoring of Cross Oaks and Providence Elementary School as it is anticipated they may reach capacity within the next five years based on Templeton's projections.

Other Options:

The District could maintain current attendance boundaries and allow for transfers until the impacted campuses reach capacity. Maintaining current boundaries would require the District address attendance boundaries in the near future to address enrollment capacity. The disadvantage to this option will be the impact to students and families adjusting to possible rezoning after attendance at a particular campus has begun.
