Item Name: CONSIDER RATIFICATION OF DONATIONS TO DISTRICT

Item Summary: The Board of Trustees delegates to the Superintendent the authority to accept unsolicited gifts on behalf of the District. However, any gift with a cost or market value of \$5,000 or more shall be presented to the Board for acknowledgment.

Gifts pending acknowledgment shall be accepted as received by the Superintendent, at his or her discretion, with a list of gifts of \$5,000 or more being presented to the Board on a quarterly basis.

Frost Elementary PTO donated \$5,835.00 to Frost Elementary School for Raz-Kids licenses.

Lamar Educational Awards Foundation (LEAF) donated \$9,989.64 to Gray Elementary School for Principal's Grant.

Hutchison PTA donated \$7,000.00 to Hutchison Elementary School for outdoor classrooms, iPads, marquee update and classroom libraries.

Marathon Fitness/Christa Davis donated \$73,340.90 in exercise equipment to Foster High School for the multi-purpose weight room, field house weight room and training room.

Texas A&M WIT donated \$9,000.00 to Randle High School for the Workforce Industry Training program.

Texas A&M WIT donated \$9,000.00 to Terry High School for the Workforce Industry Training program.
