Dear School Board Members,

I, Jessica Dietz, am planning a student trip to Panamá for June, 2020. The trip will be for any students in grades 10-12. It will be an educational and cultural experience. This will be the seventh student trip I have led, and the first time to Panamá. I am very excited to be offering a culturally focused trip in which we will be able to learn about the people, their perspectives, and also about the significance of the canal. EF tours is an accredited tour company that has been providing travel opportunities for students for over 50 years. The following is a quote from EF tours:

On tour, every student group is accompanied 24 hours a day by an EF Tour Director. Tour directors take care of all logistical details on tour—including making sure the group is always in the right place at the right time, assisting with hotel check-in, leading some of the sightseeing tours and keeping the tour running smoothly from start to finish. Included in the tour: round-trip flights, motorcoach transportation in Panama, hotel accommodations, breakfast and dinner daily with lunch provided on 3 days, entrance fees, full-time tour director, expert local guides, Global Travel Protection Plan, 24-hour Emergency Service, and EF's Peace of Mind Program. The total cost of the trip is \$2,965. Upon enrollment, students must provide a \$95 deposit to secure their spot, which is applied toward the program fee. Families can choose between two payment plan options. The first is the automatic payment plan in which payments are automatically deducted from a bank account. Families can choose their payment frequency: monthly or bi-weekly. Payments will be scheduled until 30 days prior to departure day. The other option is the manual payment plan where families make payments in less frequent installments, this option requires a deposit of \$260 (\$95 + Global Travel Protection Plan). Students will do at least three fundraisers in order to help cover costs. The opportunities will be to sell candles and snacks from a local company. We will also offer a sign-painting fundraiser party from a local company. I will offer more opportunities at the students' request.

I look forward to providing students of Crosby-Ironton with a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to engage in another culture and expand their understanding of the world through experiential learning. Thank you for your time and consideration!
