Hello Students, Parents and Guardians,

Derby City Hall and The Home Depot are sponsoring the 2018 "Extra Mile Day" which is an effort to have a city-wide clean up. The event will take place on November 1st. Derby High School students will participate in this event as a way to support "positive citizenship" in our city.

The plan is for students to start at Derby High School and start a clean-up path which follows the route below:

Start Point: Derby High School Nutmeg Ave. Hawthorne Ave. 8th St. Hawkins St. Cottage St.

Once the group reaches the corner of Cottage and Elizabeth, the group will break off into three teams:
