EXECUTIVE SUMMARY/BACKGROUND: Southfield Public Schools purchased i-Ready diagnostic and online instruction licenses for all K-8 students through Curriculum Associates for the 2020-2023 school year. i-Ready is an interim growth assessment that gives insight to growth patterns in student learning in grades K-8. The program issues online instruction for students based on the diagnostic assessment as well as gives the teachers the ability to assign effective online lessons to enhance student learning experiences. The computer adaptive test is used across the nation, allowing Curriculum Associates to conduct in depth research involving millions of student results which gives the district normative data benchmarks.

COST BENEFIT ANALYSIS: The cost of the professional development \$33,250

RECOMMENDATION: The Superintendent recommends approval of the contract to purchase the i-Ready diagnostic and online instruction licenses.

IMPACT IF NOT APPROVED: If the i-Ready professional development is not approved, instructional staff will not receive year 3 of the professional development implementation.

NEXT STEPS IF APPROVED: If approved, the i-Ready PD contract would be signed for the 2022-2023 school year
