SUBJECT: Open Enrollment

Background/Discussion:

House Bill 3681 was enacted by the 2011 legislature and provided an additional method of school choice for Oregon students. The bill did not remove Oregon's traditional methods of inter-district transfer, tuition and mutual district agreement. The house bill provides for local school districts to have control over the decision of whether to accept students using any of the methods of inter-district transfer.

Due to the enrollment changes at Spartan Academy and House of Hope and to provide a consistent student population, I am recommending to open enrollment for those two programs for up to 20 students grades 9-12. However, I would recommend that this issue be reviewed each year and our transfers In and Out be monitored as to the effectiveness of the system.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Board of Directors hereby authorize to open our enrollment for Sheridan Spartan Academy and the House of Hope for 20 students grades 9-12 as provided for in HB 3681 (which is: we open and receive applications for slots we have identified within the district)
