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### **AI Webinar for Parents/Guardians**

- Last Tuesday, November 4, Dr Warren, Dr Reynolds, and I hosted a webinar for parents and guardians at 7pm.
- There were 22 signed up for the webinar. 2 attended.
- One of the items on the sign-up form asked for questions so that we could address them during the webinar.
- I walked through a presentation that was very similar to the one presented to the Board in September.
- In addition to addressing the questions from the sign-up form, we saved time for questions near the end of the webinar.
- A Parent Committee opportunity was mentioned on the webinar, and will be offered through school newsletters. The current plan is to have information go out in December. The parent committee will meet following winter break.
- The webinar was recorded, and it will be available on YouTube in the very near future. A message will go out in the school newsletters when the video is made available.

### **D103 Cybersecurity**

- We have continued looking at options for improving our cybersecurity posture this school year.
  - We had a “penetration test” recently which looks at vulnerabilities in our network. We have not received the results of this test yet, but are excited to see where we can improve.

- We are looking at a few different options for AI powered e-mail security. We've had a large number of phishing attempts this year, and two compromised staff accounts, so we are evaluating 3 offerings to see how they may help us keep phishing and other attacks out of staff email inboxes.
