BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

The College has used cooperative contracts to save the taxpayers of the District money as well as complete projects within compressed timelines. The College is currently a member of over 10 different cooperatives all authorized by the State of Texas in Government Code 791 and Local Government Code 271.101 & 102. Many of these cooperatives are known for their outstanding contracts in certain industries. Mike Feyen, Director of Facilities for the College, has noted that the air conditioning contracts currently held by the PCA cooperative include some vendors that are located in our service area. It is our recommendation that the College join the PCA cooperative to potentially benefit from these agreements. There are no fees or dues owed by the College for membership. All costs are covered by the current vendors holding contracts.
