4. **BOARD OF TRUSTEE BUSINESS**

4.A. Discussion and action to allocate votes for one or more candidates for a position on the Central Appraisal Board of Directors for term of office beginning January 1, 2026 and ending December 31, 2029.

Dr. Arellano addressed the board regarding the allocation of 79 votes for the upcoming EPCAD elections. She explained that none of the candidates reached out to CISD seeking support. The candidates are Tanny Berg – current EPCAD Member, Jackie York – EPCAD member and local realtor, Marlene Bullard – Current Tornillo ISD board member and works at Fabens ISD, and David Duran – Councilmember of the Village of Vinton. After deliberation, the board decided to give 34 votes to David Duran since he is familiar with the Canutillo area and 15 to each of the other candidates.

Trustee Maldonado asked questions regarding the foundations for AMS and CMS. Mr. Ortiz explained that each site had unique needs; for example, at CMS, dewatering of the site was necessary.
