SASS Purpose

In conjunction with BISD, the TSC Scorpion Academy for Secondary Success (SASS) is designed to assist any senior pending graduation due to the Exit Level End of Course Exams (EOC) Requirements.

Students are provided a "head start" on college by affording them with the opportunity to take up to nine college credit hours at Texas Southmost College at no cost to the student. Example of Classes are Music, Art, Speech and English.

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- Along with the college courses, students are provided intense tutoring in the EOC subject area of concern by BISD staff.
- Students retake Exit Level EOC in the summer and continue with college courses after completion of program.
 - Students are required to apply for financial aid.
 - Students are encouraged to continue with college courses for second session and beyond.


