Background Information:

- The Local Government Purchasing Cooperative was created to increase the purchasing power of governmental entities and to simplify their purchasing by use of the BuyBoard purchasing system.
- This Cooperative is administered by the Texas Association of School Boards and is endorsed by the Texas Municipal League and the Texas Association of Counties. It is open to all local governments, nonprofits, and other political subdivisions, and Texas school districts must be a member of TASB to participate.
- All items and catalogs posted on the BuyBoard have been competitively procured and awarded by the Cooperative's Board of Trustees based on Texas statutes. The end result is a reduction in administrative efforts while maintaining compliance with competitive bidding requirements.
