
Band Hall Re-Roofing Project

- Raba Kistner Roof Consultants
- ❖ Water was seeping through building walls and depositing dampness through the concrete masonry units (CMU) cavity, therefore staining the interior walls of band hall room and adjacent areas. Maintenance initiated a temporary fix until we solicit roofing contractor.
- * Roofing consultant has been contacted to provide necessary measures to remediate.









- ❖ Replaced existing campus wide lighting luminaires with latest energy efficient technology Light Emitting Diode (LED) lighting systems.
- Main panels and wiring is complete
- Control switches pending in order to complete project
- Surveying Elementary schools to identify lighting needs.
- Goal to upgrade 2 more schools)



- Schematics were provided by Facility staff and SIGMA Engineering provide electrical design.


Parking Lot Expansion

- ☐ Estimated Construction Timeline: 120 days



Elementary Cafeteria Stages

Reconfigure stage to make it ADA accessible





- ☐ Need ramp(s) to allow students in a wheelchair to access stage.
- ☐ Code Compliance Requirements
- ☐ Will secure an estimate for 34 elementary campuses.

Contract does NOT include the following:

☐ Exterior speakers for students outside in playground, track and field events, etc.
