Re: 2022-2023 Campus Drills

All campuses have entered their drills into the Navigate 360 Emergency Management Suite for the entire 2022-2023 school year.

The District is following the "I love you guy's foundation" Standard Response Protocols (STP). The STP's are the following; Lockdown, Secured, Hold, Evacuation, and Shelter. District will be conduct monthly fire drills and at least one reunification drill each campus. A minimum of two lockdown drills will be done per school year at each campus. Campuses may conduct additional STP's drills throughout the school year above the minimum drills required. The drills listed below are the minimum suggested by the Texas School Safety Center.

Drills: 17 Drills total per campus

Fire Drill	10 (1 per Month) - Local Fire Marshall
Lockdown	2 per year, 1 per semester
Secured	1 per year
Hold	1 per year
Evacuate	1 per year
Shelter	1 per year
Reunification	1 per year
