

None of this policy is in code. This is a combination of two IDLA policies that were drafted when the District first started using IDLA. It was used for Caribou High Graduation etc. High school personnel have assisted in revising this to reflect all online courses.

Soda Springs School District 150 will use Idaho Digital Learning Academy (IDLA)/Online Courses to supplement and replace the curriculum, allowing homebound students to take classes at home, and provide a full curriculum at Soda Springs School District. Teachers, counselors, and administrators will strive to identify those students who will benefit from on-line classes and to counsel those who will not meet the additional demands of on-line classes accordingly. Enrollment and funding in IDLA/Online Course is a privilege, not a right. IDLA/Online Courses are a supplement to the regular offerings at Soda Springs High School and are not considered an alternative selection to present offerings. Students may be denied the privilege of IDLA/Online Courses enrollment if their academic and behavior record does not indicate the academic ability and self-discipline needed to succeed in on-line learning. IDLA courses taken through Soda Springs School District 150 are state approved high school and junior high courses and will be so regarded and recorded on student transcripts as such. Other Online courses must be approved by the building principal as meeting these standards.

Students are responsible for paying for IDLA/Online courses. The District will provide supervised lab space for designated times during the regular school day. IDLA students will be counted as enrolled Soda Springs School District students for attendance and financial purposes. District funding may be made available for IDLA/On-line courses if the course is set up as the only alternative to a required course for a group of students. The building principal will approve such offerings as needed.

The building principal is responsible to monitor student enrollment to ensure students are eligible. Students will be allowed to enroll in a maximum of two IDLA/Online courses per grading period unless they have met graduation requirements. . All IDLA class enrollments require approval from the counselor and principal.
