## ELIGIBILITY OF RESIDENT/NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

The Board of Education establishes the following residency policy for determining eligibility to participate in the programs offered by this District.

The Board will educate, tuition-free, only those students who are, or whose parents are, legal residents of the District's, regardless of their citizenship or immigration status. The Board shall meaningfully communicate material information about enrollment requirements and procedures with parents, including parents who have limited proficiency in English. Access to information regarding enrollment requirements and procedures shall be available on the District's web site constituent local school districts.

Nonresident students may be accepted into the Vocational and/or Special Education program provided by this District on a tuition or special fee basis.

Students, residing in the District but not living with their parents, guardian, or person who qualifies in place of the parent, shall be ineligible to participate in District programs unless said students can be considered emancipated minors by court decree and has proved the establishment of an independent residence.
