Student culture:

- TOPS celebrated Arab American Heritage month and honored the contributions of members of our school and local communities.

- Re-registration season is open. To date, 73% of families have said that they plan to return to TOPS next school year.

Academics:

- Teachers, interventionists, and engagement specialists continued to support students in completing required HB4545 tutoring hours.
- With the support of instructional coaches, teachers and interventionists created live and asynchronous reviews in preparation STAAR/EOC testing.
- High School teachers and counselors continue to support seniors on finishing strong by passing their classes and earning their CCMR point.
- TOPS has achieved an average of 96% tested on all STAARs/EOCs administered so far.
