Campus Staffing Guidelines 2017-2018
For Educational Program Standards of Service

Elementary Educational Program Standards of Service:

- 22:1 Class size in PK-4
- 24:1 Class size in Grade 5*
- Art (1 Art teacher per campus--additional .5 or 1.0 if required by campus size)
- Music (1 Music teacher per campus--additional .5 or 1.0 if required by size)
- PE (1 PE teacher per campus; additional teachers and/or assistants if required by size)
- Special Ed. staff as required by programs, ARDs, and approved by Sp. Ed. Dept.
- Bilingual/ESL staff as required by program and LPACs.
- TAG teachers as required by number of students per campus and approved by GT Dept.
- Instructional support staff per staffing ratios (ie: librarian, counselor, nurse, etc.)

Middle School Educational Program Standards of Service:

- Core academic class size student –to-teacher ratio of 23:1 (See Choice Sheet for approved courses in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies)
- Core academic interventions (scheduled for struggling students only)
- Daily collaborative planning period for core academic area teachers (core academic area teachers with 5 teaching classes in a 7 period day schedule, or the equivalent if campus schedule is not based on a 7 period day)
- PE teachers (to meet requirement: 2 semesters in grade six and 2 semesters in 7/8)
- Fine Arts teachers to meet 6th grade Fine Arts requirement
- Technology Education teachers to meet 1 semester requirement (see choice sheet)
- Elective teachers to meet elective requirements (see choice sheet for courses)
 - Fine Arts
 - World languages
 - Health
 - Technology Education beyond 1 semester requirement
 - Other CTE Electives required/approved electives (TEKS-based course)
- Athletics (coaches teach 4 academic classes in addition to athletics periods and planning period)
- Special Ed. staff as required by programs, ARDs, and approved by Sp. Ed. Dept. (see choice sheet Special Ed. options for approved courses)
- ESL staff as required by program and LPACs (See choice sheet for approved courses)
- TAG teachers as required (1 per school)
- Pre-AP teachers (part of classroom teacher allocation; assignment based on enrollment)
- AVID teacher (if approved for AVID course)
- Leadership Cadet Corps (if approved for LCC program may be used as PE equivalent)
- Instructional support staff per staffing ratios (ie: librarian, counselor, nurse, etc.)

High School Educational Program Standards of Service:

- Core academic area student-to-teacher ratio of 25:1 (See Choice Sheet for approved courses in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies)
- Core academic interventions (scheduled for struggling students only)
- Daily collaborative planning period for core academic area teachers (core academic area teachers with 5 teaching classes in a 7 period day schedule, or the equivalent if campus schedule is not based on a 7 period day)
- Elective teachers to meet requirements of Recommended High School Grad. Plan
 - Fine Arts
 - EP (or PE equivalent)
 - Health
 - Communication Applications
 - Technology Applications
 - World Languages
 - CTE Courses
 - JROTC
 - AVID (if approved for AVID course)
 - Other core area electives (see choice sheet)
- Other Elective teachers required/approved for new HS pathways
- Athletics (coaches teach 4 academic classes in addition to athletics periods and planning period)
- Special Ed. staff as required by programs, ARDs, and approved by Sp. Ed. Dept. (See choice sheet Special Ed. graduation options for approved courses)
- ESL staff as required by program and LPACs (See choice sheet for approved courses)
- Pre-AP and AP teachers as required by enrollment of TAG students and open enrollment of non-TAG students
- Instructional support staff per staffing ratios (ie: librarian, counselor, nurse, etc.)
