We are pleased to inform you that Sheridan School District will implement a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for School Year 2015-2016

**What does this mean for you and your children?** Great news for you and your children!

All enrolled students of

**Faulconer-Chapman School, Sheridan High School, Spartan Academy and House of Hope**

are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2015-2016 school year. No further action is required of you. Your children will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay for meals or submit an application.

If your children attend schools that are not participating in CEP, your household may still need to fill out a confidential meal application or pay for meals.
